# 1. Introduction

- 1.1. As a result of the new approaches applied in education, 21st century students acquire knowledge and skills in the fields of science necessary for the development of various fields of modern society. It is as a result of this that a young generation that can contribute to society by applying their knowledge and skills to solve real-life problems has started to form.
- 1.2. The main goal of organizing the "Exhibition of Innovative Projects" within the SAF 2023 is to reveal talented students of different age groups, as well as to create conditions for further development of potential.

## 2. Terms of Participation

- 2.1. "Exhibition of innovative projects" is designed for group participation at general secondary, full secondary, vocational, technical vocational, higher vocational, secondary specialized, as well as higher education levels.
- 2.2. Each team should have 1 leader and 2 or 3 team members.
- 2.3. The project content is defined in two areas - "**Smart solutions in natural disasters**" and "**Medicine and innovative technology**". Students of all educational levels and fields will demonstrate their innovative projects aimed at solving the problem in the mentioned areas. The main goal of promoting the directions mentioned in the "Exhibition of Innovative Projects" is to focus the students on the solution of existing global problems, as well as the contribution they can make to social development.

## 3. Application Method

- 3.1. Applications will be accepted through the official website of SAF (<https://saf.steam.edu.az/>).

## 4. Qualification Stage

- 4.1. The selection of projects for the exhibition at the festival will be made by determined judges. Teams that have registered and submitted their projects within the specified period will participate in the selection stage. The selection of projects will be made before the festival.
- 4.2. In the assessment conducted for the purpose of selection, criteria such as relevance, innovativeness, functionality, uniqueness and presentation of the project topic will be taken into account (**Table 1**).

Conditions	Points
Relevance - relevance of the project content in modern world	10
Innovativeness – application of innovative approaches in the implementation of the project idea	20
Functionality – Functionality of the developed model, prototype or other project product	30
Uniqueness – A new (non-repeating) project idea and product	30
Presentation – conveying ideas or information in a clear, systematic manner within a given time, while also using appropriate tone of voice, body language, eye contact, etc.	10
